SCALING & ROOT PLANING

The built-in bite block and variable suction provided by the Mouthpiece and Isolite control head allows hygienists to stay on schedule and reduce delays in the chair. Patients are more comfortable and don't need to rinse and spit because of the continuous evacuation of fluid, blood, and calculus. Anesthetic is less likely to wear off when treatments are completed efficiently.



SEALANTS

It's possible for one patient's entire mouth to be sealed in less than 8 minutes with one hygienist, because Isolite lets hygienists etch two quadrants simultaneously. Etch is rinsed and evacuated quickly without having your patient taste the etch or stop and spit. Cure multiple sealants at the same time without tongue or saliva contamination. There's no need for an additional assistant to keep the mouth dry or hold evacuation tools during treatment.



CAVITRON

When using Isolite with a Cavitron, there's no need to go slowly or stop frequently to evacuate saliva or calculus. The Mouthpiece provides better lingual and buccal visibility while exposing teeth and gums and holding the tongue out of the way. Isolite frees up one hand that would otherwise be used to evacuate during the procedure. There's little need for other suction during Cavitron procedures.



DENTAL PROPHYLAXIS

When performing a prophylaxis with an Isolite, hygienists can help reduce the procedure time for patients. Fluoride varnish can be applied faster, because they are working in a drier field. Continuous and variable suction means the patient doesn't need to rinse and stop to spit.
